Call for Applications: Summer School on the Political Economy of Andhra Pradesh

The Institute for Research on Andhra Pradesh (IRAP) invites applications for its inaugural Summer School programme from PhD scholars, early-career academics, and committed activists engaged with questions of development, inequality, and social transformation in Andhra Pradesh. Over two intensive days, the Summer School curriculum will provide an analysis of agrarian transformations, urban restructuring, ecological challenges, and socio-political processes through an intersectional lens attentive to caste, class, and gender. The Summer School is designed as a collaborative platform for dialogue and exchange. Participants will have the opportunity to interact with scholars and practitioners from leading universities and research institutions in India and abroad, as well as civil society organisations such as Mahila Kisan Adhikaar Manch (MAKAAM). The aim is to strengthen ongoing research and activist engagements while fostering solidarities across academic and grassroots spaces.

The Summer School has two key objectives:

- First, to enable participants to approach their fields of inquiry with sharper critical perspectives on social and political processes of the AP.
- Second, to explore innovative methods and pedagogies and to collectively produce reflective write-ups that contribute to expanding democratic and political spaces with transformative agendas.

Who is eligible?

PhD students, early-career academics (assistant & associate professors), independent researchers and activists engaged in social movements and voluntary work with a focus exclusively on Andhra Pradesh.

Format of the Summer School:

- Lectures, Workshops and Discussions

What to Submit:

Applicants are required to submit a CV and a one-page note outlining their interest and/or their ongoing work related to Andhra Pradesh. For academic scholars, the note should clearly indicate the research problem, approach, and its relevance. Activists should write about their engagement with the issues that they are working on. - Summer School Sessions: Friday, July 31st; Saturday, August 1st, 2026
